Hede (Lead Singer):

The Voice of the Rebellion

Some frontmen sing. Hede commands. He doesn't whisper sweet nothings — he spits raw truths straight at your face. Every word from Hede's throat is a spark that lights the fire. With lyrics ripped from restless nights, rebellion, heartbreak, and a deep hunger for something real, Hede turns every stage into a confessional and every crowd into a choir of outcasts.

Bendy (Lead Guitar):

The Six-String Sorcerer

The riff architect. The solo assassin. The wizard with a six-string. Bendy's fingers dance like they're possessed — classic rock roots, modern edge, and a mind that knows exactly when to slice clean and when to cut deep. His harmonies twist your gut, his solos melt your face. If you hear fire, it's probably him.

Bellz (Rhythm Guitar):

The Riff Machine

If LastFrontPage's sound is a freight train, Bellz is the iron track beneath it. His riffs are thick, relentless walls of sound that hold the chaos steady and keep the storm on course. Solid, unshakable, but always ready to knock you sideways with a sudden, crushing breakdown. With Bellz behind the rhythm, there's no escape.

Dalle (Bass):

The Thunder Beneath

Low end is an afterthought for some bands — not here. Dalle's basslines are more than notes. They're earthquakes under your feet. He locks in with Nick The Stick to build grooves so heavy you feel them in your bones. A pulse that ties the riffs to the roar and keeps the whole beast stomping forward, no matter how wild it gets.

Nick The Stick (Drums):

The Engine Room

Nick The Stick doesn't just keep time — he bends it to his will. His drumming is a nod to the giants of classic rock, fused with the relentless drive of '80s metal and a dash of punk swagger for good measure. Every stick hit is a warning shot. Every fill is a call to arms. He's the reason your neck hurts after the show.
